A residential workshop, conducted by Walter Logeman, open to psychodrama trainees, including those from other institutes. (This workshop is not included as part of the annual CITP programme.)

Psychodrama is a theatrical method and directing means you need to be able to think clearly, be fully present, have a vision and be articulate. Writing helps with that. Participants will identify and work on their current writing task. We will have two three hour structured sessions, one on Saturday and one on Sunday. These sessions include writing, conversation and drama to assist the writing. The rest of the time: productive writing and some time for walks.
